## 2. Status Quo Component 1 - overview

- 1st and 2nd progress report submitted see separate slide
- Project audit see separate slide
- 1st and 2nd shared costs invoice sent out;
   all partners paid 1st sharing costs invoice;
   2nd shall be paid by 15 June 2011

## 2. Status Quo – Component 11st & 2nd Progress report (PR)

- Both progress reports submitted within the deadlines
- 10 partners reported costs
- JTS' feedback on 2nd PR pending, 2nd payment expected for June '11
- Reported expenditure so far: 460.000 EUR
- Underspending: > 400.000 EUR

Cost not claimed on time might lead to loss of funding.







## 2. Status Quo – Component 1 - Audit

- Audit (=2nd level control) by Ernst & Young (March '11)
- Land Schleswig-Holstein & Navarre region were scrutinized
- Currently waiting for audit report
- Audits might happen any time again & result in payback claims
  - make sure to only claim costs which were actually paid out and keep all the invoices, calculation methods public procurement documentation etc.
