4. Associate Partner's objectives, usual activities and sources of financing:

The Ústí Region has extensive experience in crisis management in compliance with Act No. 240/2000 Coll., (the so called Crisis Management Act). The crisis management portal has been in operation on the territory of the Ústí Region since 2008. Its purpose is to inform both the professional and the general public about emergency situations. The Ústí Region has also across-the-border experience in crisis management, e.g. Czech-Saxon cooperation. The Ústí Region is financed by public, state funds.

5. Associate Partner's contribution to the project (detailed description of tasks, responsibilities and input to the project):

The main role of the Ústí Region in the RIPEDS project (Requirements for the critical road infrastructure protection from the effects of dangerous goods) will mainly consist in providing consulting and advisory services. Key information regarding the type and means of road transport of dangerous goods in relation to the location of critical infrastructure features, statistical data or other information related to the project solution will be obtained through the Ústí Region. Dissemination of the project results and publicity are also expected to be carried out through the Ústí Region affiliations.

Note: If in the period between the invitation to participate in the project with international cooperation and the binding deadline by which the application must be carried out there is no scheduled meeting of the Ústí Region Council during which it would be possible to take a decision on the international cooperation (which is the subject matter of the situation that has arisen), the following procedure can be taken: If the deadline for the application is not extended, proceed with the application within the deadline, however on condition – the Ústí Region will apply with an explicit written suspensive condition stating that the Ústí Region Council will approve the participation in the project at its next meeting. Failure to comply with the condition means that the application has no legal effect. However, this procedure must be consulted in advance with the subject which has invited the Ústí Region to participate in the project. For the original of this decision, please see the attached PDF document. A positive decision of the Ústí Region is expected with regard to the participation in the RIPEDS project.


