The joint promotion of the region without borders will help remove current information barriers and will support overall development of the Ore Mountains and the neighbouring area called Podkrušnohoří.

For many years this area has been trying to change its image, which is perceived rather negatively especially on the Czech side due to mining and historical devastation of environment. From a different point of view, you can see a unique area, which can offer incredible experiences to a visitor. The Ore Mountains hide a lot of amazing places, which are certainly worth seeing. The guide provides several tips for interesting outings that will help you understand the history and wild beauty of this area.

We believe that you will fall in love with the Ore Mountains and that you will be happy to come back again.

Did you know that...

- ...the Ore Mountains are an attractive place all the year round.
- ...the Valley of Bezruč is one of the longest, deepest and most beautiful valleys of the Ore Mountains created by an activity of the Chomutovka River.
- ...the Hasištejn Castle was probably set up as early as at the beginning of 14th century in order to protect significant trading routes leading from Bohemia to Saxon Annaberg. J. W. Goethe visited the castle in 1810.
- ...a great tip for hikers are Hiking Weeks called “echt Erzgebirge“ (“genuine Ore Mountains“) that always take place from Saturday of the third to Sunday of the fourth weekend in May and September, including accompaniment of a guide.
- ...a mining town of Freiberg is celebrating its 850th anniversary this year. The town of silver is celebrating throughout the whole year of 2012; one of many events is an anniversary of the first discoveries of silver, which helped the town achieve fame and wealth. Events such as the mining town celebrations, which takes place from 24 June to 1 July including a parade of miners, The Saxon Day, which takes place on the first weekend of September, and mining music days are the highlight of the programme being prepared.
- ...over the past decades thousands of people in Czech spas have checked out the treating power of peat that is plentiful in the Ore Mountains.
- ...Cracked Rock – a striking rock of a reddish colour not far from the Dam of Fláje – works as a natural lightning conductor due to its exposed position.
- ...you can find the deepest chateau well (130.6 m) at the Augustusburg Chateau? The Hunting Lodge and the Augustusburg Folly have been rising in the altitude of 516 m above the Zschopau Valley for more than 400 years. Various events such as the chateau theatre and the winter meeting of bikers are worth attending.
- ...Annaberger Kät in Annaberg-Buchholz, taking place between 9 and 17 June 2012, is the greatest celebration of the Ore Mountains. Action and fun with a furious ride, fast twists and a rich offer for the whole family including international culinary specialties.
- ...the Fichtelbergbahn railway has been transporting passengers between Cranzahl and the spa of Oberwiesenthal for 115 years already. It is celebrating its anniversary together with Erzgebirgsbahn, which is celebrating its 10th anniversary. Numerous attractions will be prepared for both small and adult fans of these machines on 2 and 3 June.



1 THE MUSEUM OF ORE MOUNTAINS IN LESNÁ

Not far from the towns of Chomutov and Most, you can come across a small mountain settlement called Lesná. Only five renovated or newly constructed buildings are left from the village, which originally had 29 houses. One of them is the Museum of Ore Mountains, which presents the Ore-Mountain Folk House from 1873. Near this museum there is a replica of a chapel with a belfry including an original bell that chimes each hour and thus can serve as a landmark in fog or a snowstorm. Visitors have the opportunity to try to bake bread or gingerbread, to work a bobbin, or to try wire repairs, to work on the potter's wheel, weaving, weaving on a spinning wheel, etc., with their own two hands. The exhibition also offers a collection of old farm machinery and a variety of exhibitions on the second floor of the house. The museum in Lesná opens daily and offers guided tours on weekends. The entrance fee is voluntary.

2 THE VALLEY OF BEZRUČ

One of the longest (13 km), deepest and most beautiful valleys of the Ore Mountains that was created by an activity of the Chomutovka River is the Valley of Bezruč. In 2002 it was declared a National Park. From the town of Chomutov you can take a nature trail lined with many informative signs and boards pointing out natural, technical and historical sites. Our tip for your outing is a stroll to the Bear Waterfalls. The best way to get there is to take a trip from the second Mill following the Chomutovka River stream towards the Mount of St. Sebastian. By an abandoned building built of bricks at a place called "Tišina" follow a footpath and after about 300 m you reach the Bear Waterfalls. Nearby you will find the Novodomské peat bog, Buky nad Kameničkou reservation, Křímov and Kamenička reservoirs, Sokolí hnízdo (Falcon's Nest) viewing tower, and many other interesting places.

3 SPHINX BY MĚDĚNEC

"The Ore Mountains through the eyes of Sphinx", is how the beautiful view of an interesting and rare rock formation near Měděnec may be described. The rock was named after its shape, which looks like a Sphinx's head. It is located southeast of the village of Měděnec. Since 1983, these rocks have been protected as a natural heritage monument. These rocks offer a very nice view of the Ore and Doupovské Mountains and of the picturesque valley of the Ohře River. This site is a popular summer destination, but it has its charm in winter as well, when the landscape is buried under snow and the trees look like they are in a fairytale. Biking trail No. 35 passes by this natural monument.

4 CHLUMEC

Chlumec is surrounded by the Ore Mountains and by rich history, including the well-known battle at Chlumec dating back to 1813. Even today you can still find rusty cannonballs or parts of military equipment in the vicinity of the town. The importance of one of the bloodiest battles of the Napoleonic wars is demonstrated by many monuments scattered along the way from Nakléřov to Teplice. In Chlumec you may see a monument commemorating the famous battle and also the remnants of an old fortress and crosses of reconciliation. The most visited events in Chlumec are reconstructions of the famous battle at Chlumec, as well as a traditional country-folk festival called Chlumecký goulash.

5 AUGUST HORCH MUSEUM IN ZWICKAU

6 STEAM NARROW GAUGE RAILWAYS

Black iron horses whizz through the landscape gracefully and full of power. Only four Saxon narrow-gauge railways with 750 mm gauge out of nineteen have been preserved in the Ore Mountains up to now – Fichtelbergbahn, Preßnitztalbahn, Schönheide-Carlsfeld Railway Museum and Weißeritztalbahn. Even now those who are keen on these elderly ladies radiate happiness when they take a ride through the most beautiful valleys of the Ore Mountains.

The Park of Miniatures “Klein Erzgebirge“ Oederan


In the oldest park of miniatures in Central Europe and the second oldest one in the world, in the area of the Ore Mountains in Oederan, you can find the most beautiful constructions of the Ore Mountains in a detailed manner and scale of 1:25. You can admire more than 1,300 hand-made works of castles, chateaus, mines, mills, and bridges here. Moving figures represent everyday work of craftsmen.

“Heimatecke” (Corner of Motherland) Waschleithe

In the touring facility called Heimatecke (Corner of Motherland), which is located in the romantic Oswaldthal Valley by Schwarzenberg, you can find approximately 90 models of significant constructions of the Ore Mountains. Small works of art were made as authentic detailed miniatures in the scale of 1:40.


