


Trial 'Plan an action' interactive workshop'

- The main aim of this workshop was to show to the future trainers how to make an interesting, interactive workshop on national level, which helps local level stakeholders to have a deeper knowledge of the complexity of the demographic problems, and also helps the trainers to clarify the main focus points, funding options, define key stakeholders, steps of the actions.
- A sample action was presented on the workshop based on the case of the municipality of Ozd, which is a town in Northern Hungary with high unemployment - and fertility rate, and with low infrastructure and education level amongst citizens and with bad life expectancy.
- The interactive workshop used the technique of the demographic coaching program, which is one of the pilot actions of the ADAPT2DC project, focused on the main problems of the sample town, using a problem tree to visualize the challenges and defined main stakeholders, objectives, actions and funding possibilities..
