2. ZPRÁVA O VÝSLEDCÍCH BILATERÁLNÍHO SETKÁNÍ

2.1 Místo, průběh a výsledky bilaterálního setkání, v případě změn oproti žádosti uveďte jejich zdůvodnění Setkání partnerů se konalo ve dnech 4. 9. a 5. 9. 2019 (3. 9. – 6. 9. 2019 včetně cesty) v Reykjavíku na Islandu. Počet účastníků z ČR: 2 osoby (Jitka Šrejberová, Adam Šrejber), počet účastníků z donorského státu: 2 osoby (Anna Þorbjörg Þorgrímsdóttir, Nathalie Jacqueminet).

1. den na Reykjavíkur Akademían (The Reykjavik Academy) – proběhla přednáška/prezentace českých zástupců k péči o kulturní dědictví v ČR a na úrovni Ústeckého kraje. Byla představena historie starého města Most, jeho osud a likvidace. Dále bylo ze strany české delegace představeno 5 uměleckých děl (velkoformátových obrazů), která budou součástí projektu v hlavní výzvě. Proběhla intenzivní diskuse o stavu těchto uměleckých děl a způsobu jejich záchrany. Ze strany partnera z donorského státu byla přislíbena spolupráce na projektu v hlavní výzvě, a to v pozici odborného konzultanta k restaurování uměleckých děl. Ředitelka Reykjavíkur Akademían představila české delegaci roli a fungování této instituce na Islandu.

2. den v National Museum of Iceland v Reykjavíku, a to v hlavní budově muzea a v Kulturním domě, pobočce muzea.

Ze strany partnera z donorského státu byla dojednána bezplatná návštěva muzea. Česká delegace se seznámila s fungování péče o kulturní dědictví Islandu, včetně jeho prezentace veřejnosti.

V obou dnech došlo k výměně zkušeností v oblasti péče o kulturní dědictví a byl dohodnut společný postup k projektu v hlavní výzvě. Dále došlo k bližšímu osobnímu a profesnímu poznání zainteresovaných osob.



Report on the Bilateral Meeting

The partners' meeting was held in Reykjavík (Iceland) on the 4th of September and 5th of September 2019 (including a trip on September 3, 2019 – September 6, 2019). The number of participants from the Czech Republic: two persons (Jitka Šrejberová, Adam Šrejber), the number of participants from the donor state: two persons (Anna Þorbjörg Þorgrímsdóttir, Nathalie Jacqueminet).

The first day at the "Reykjavíkur Akademían" (The Reykjavík Academy):

The talk/presentation on the cultural heritage preservation in the Czech Republic and at the level of the Ústí Region took place. The history of the old city Most, its destiny and demolition were presented as well. Moreover, five large-format artworks which will be a part of a project in a main call were described. An intensive discussion on the state of conservation of these artworks and the way of their restoration was carried out. The cooperation on the project in the main call has been promised by a partner from the donor state in a position of a professional adviser on the restoration of the artworks in question. The directress of the "Reykjavíkur Akademían" presented the role and activity of this institution in Iceland to the Czech delegation.

The second day at the National Museum of Iceland (Reykjavik) – the main building and the branch building (the Cultural House):


The gratis visit of the museum was organized by the partner of the donor state. The Czech delegation was introduced into the system of the cultural heritage preservation in Iceland, including its presentation to public.





The Restoration Project "The Rescued Cultural Heritage of the Old Town of Most"

Dr. Jitka Šrejberová – Dr. Adam Šrejber





The project is planned by the Ustí Region in cooperation with the Regional Museum and Gallery in Most. The Ústí Region is a regional authority with specific competences and administration. It is setting up the most important organisations and institutions in the north-west Bohemia and is an owner of collections which are preserved in its museums and art museums. The region is planning a project of the restoration of large-format paintings which originate from buildings of the demolished historic city Most. The artworks in question are deposited in the collection of the Regional Museum and Gallery in Most.

Most is a city in the Ústí Region of the Czech Republic. It is situated between the Central Bohemian Uplands and the Ore Mountains. The name "Most" means "bridge" in Czech. The German name for Most is Brüx (derived from the German word for "bridge", Brücke). It is based on the system of bridges that crossed the swamps in this area on a trade route between Prague and Freiberg (Saxony) in the early Middle Ages. The historic city had a benefit from the trade first of all. It has been known for its heavy industry since the 19th century. The coal mining was a reason of the extinction of the historic city.

1965. It was started by a decision of the former Czechoslovak Socialist Republic in 1964. The demolition lasted until the 1st of April 1987. The old town Most had a closed historic centre with many historic buildings dated into the Middle Ages. Many of them were protected as a immovable cultural heritage and the town had a specific *genius loci*. Its historic urban landscape was highly-valued and the town could have been characterized as a pearl at the foothills of the Ore Mountains.

Although the historic centre was completely destroyed to make room for the expanding lignite mines, it was decided to save the church by moving it away from mining area. The transfer was overseen by the firm Transfera Praha, an organisation of the Czech Ministry of Culture. The preparation work lasted seven years, as it was also necessary to demolish all houses in the transfer path and fill in the former opencast mine.

53 transport trucks were set on special rails, which were inserted under all statically important points of the building. These transport trucks worked using computer controlled hydraulics, as were four booms used to pull the church. During movement of the church on the road section, rails which had already been passed over were moved from behind the building to in front of it, allowing them to be used again.

Between September 30 and October 27, 1975, the church was moved a distance of 841.1 meters at a velocity of 1–3 centimeters per minute to the vicinity of the old hospital with a small church of the Holy Spirit, and it was set on an iron-concrete two-storied foundation. After the move was completed, restoration work went on until 1988, and the church was consecrated again in 1993. *(English Version via Wikipedia)*





The Regional Museum and Gallery in Most

This regional organisation was founded as a German Municipal Museum in 1888 and its art collection is one of the largest of the Ústí Region. Its foundation is built on a collection of artworks rescued during the adaptation of the interior of the decanal church in Most in the 1880^s, and the activities of the local Association of Friends of the Museum.

ABOUT COLLECTION

1) an important role of the museum in the preservation of cultural heritage of the old town Most;

2) a museum building has been declared as a protected cultural heritage since 1994 – it is a relict of the old town Most and was built as a German boys' high school according plans of architects Adolf Schwarzer and Otto Reinhardt between 1911–1913; 3) some of protected cultural heritage properties and relicts of the historic city Most are a part of a museum collection; 4) the old town Most is animated on the basis of these relicts; 5) the rich fine art collection in the context with the museum building is used for telling a story about the extinct town; 6) in the collection there are drawings, graphics, paintings in connection with Most and transfers of wall paintings, sculpture and carvings which decorated the defunct buildings of the historic city.

Target: "The object of the aforementioned project is artworks" salvaged from buildings of the old town of Most. It was sequentially demolished between the 1960s and 1980s as a result of local coal mining. Although the highly-valuable architectural heritage of the old town of Most, of which only a small part — including the relocated decanal church — was possible to preserve, has disappeared irrevocably, it is attempting to protect and take good care of the cultural *heritage retrieved from the defunct buildings. The project* focuses on the art collection of the museum, of which preferentially selected for restoration were large-format Baroque paintings from the churches of Most, as well as a large-format canvas by the famous Czech painter Alphonse Mucha from the banking house."





Main activities and outputs of the project:

(1) restoration of large-format paintings from demolished buildings of the old town of Most and their presentation;

(2) cooperation in the field of the conservation science (including laboratory research), art conservation and restoration in process (universities), a laboratory research, where it is needed - in cooperation with the Academic Laboratory of the Academy of Fine Arts in Prague;
(3) art history research, archive research and bibliography, developing the scientific knowledge and presentation of the cultural heritage of the old town of Most;

(4) educational activities for 1/ primary, as well as secondary schools, 2/ a local community, as well as local Roma minority (lectures);

(5) methodology for the museum staff of the Ústí Region;

(6) publications (about 2, no more than 3);


(7) publicity, including a panel exhibition on the project accompanied by a workshop;

(8) cooperation with the **community**: mapping of historic iconography (photos, drawings, etc.) of exteriors and interiors of demolished buildings not only from which the artworks originate.


